Item 134-01 – 1909, **St. John NB**, US 1c Franklin on Valentine postcard (Entrance to Suspension Bridge view). Cannot be / forwarded unpaid (2 lines hs), sent to **St. John Local Dead Letter Office**, cancelled with double ovals 44mm x31mm (very scarce and a few known), postage paid and forwarded to destination. Very scarce DLO item. \$80.00



Item 134-02 – 1902, **London Ont**, 2c Numeral tied by duplex on George White & Sons Co advertising cover. G. White arrived in London in 1857 and decided to stay and open up a blacksmith and general repair shop. Later, he built **agricultural steam engines** and more known as White's Threshing Engines. A print out of the White history accompanies. \$125.00



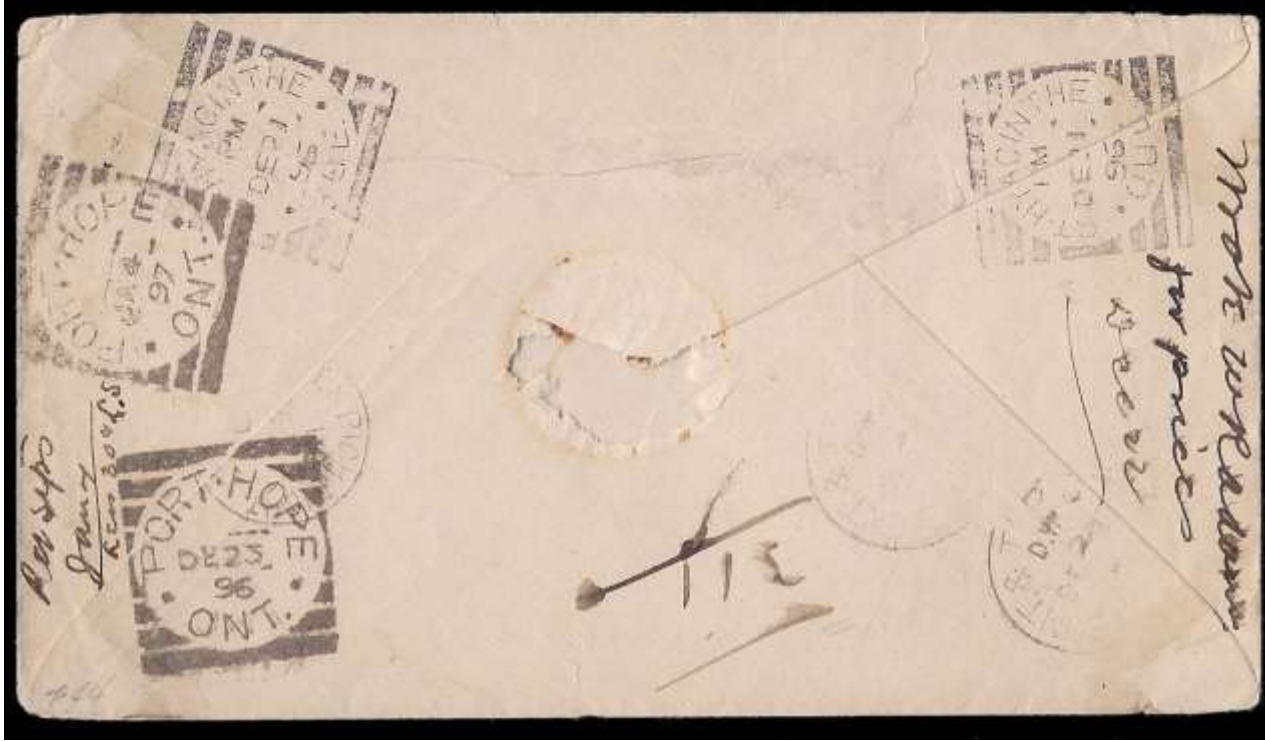
Item 134-03 – 1931, **St.Regis Que** (Mohawk Nation of Akwesasne Territory), 3c Arch tied by **2 RING "40"** on Sun Life c/c. Listed in Unitrade page 573 without rarity factor. \$200.00



Item 134-04 – 1847, **River du Loup LC** (Maskinonge County), 1829 type in red, paid 9d to Hatley via Three Rivers. Long letter written in English enclosed. \$100.00



Item 134-05 – 1911, **Regina Sask**, 2c Edward tied by IMC on **Dominion Exposition** advertising cover. \$100.00



Item 134-06 – 1896, **St.Hyacinthe Que**, (2) 1c, (2) 3c SQ tied by squared circle (PM/DE/21/96) paying 8c registered letter rate to Port Hope on **Yamaska Stamp Company** advertising cover. \$150.00

Item 134-07 – 1911, Montreal Que, 2c Edward tied by IMC on Laporte, Martin & Co advertising cover. Back cover promoting the Mitchell Scotch and Irish Whisky. Item 134-08 – 1910, **Winnipeg Man**, 1c Edward tied by IMC on 1c Edward stationery postcard paying 2c UPU postcard rate to Suriname. Message is stamp exchange related. Scarce destination. **\$125.00 SOLD**



Item 134-09 – 1928, Toronto Ont, 2c Admiral tied by slogan paying 2c preferred letter rate to Cuba. Receiver (4 days). \$80.00



Item 134-10 – 1944, British Field Post Office 598 (used by SC 63 in 1944) on Armed Forces Air Letter **Christmas Issue** to Port Arthur Ont. \$125.00



Item 134-11 – 1919, Toronto Ont, 3c Admiral tied by slogan K-25 (**Keep our farms and factories busy, buy victory bonds**). Very scarce slogan. **\$30.00 SOLD**



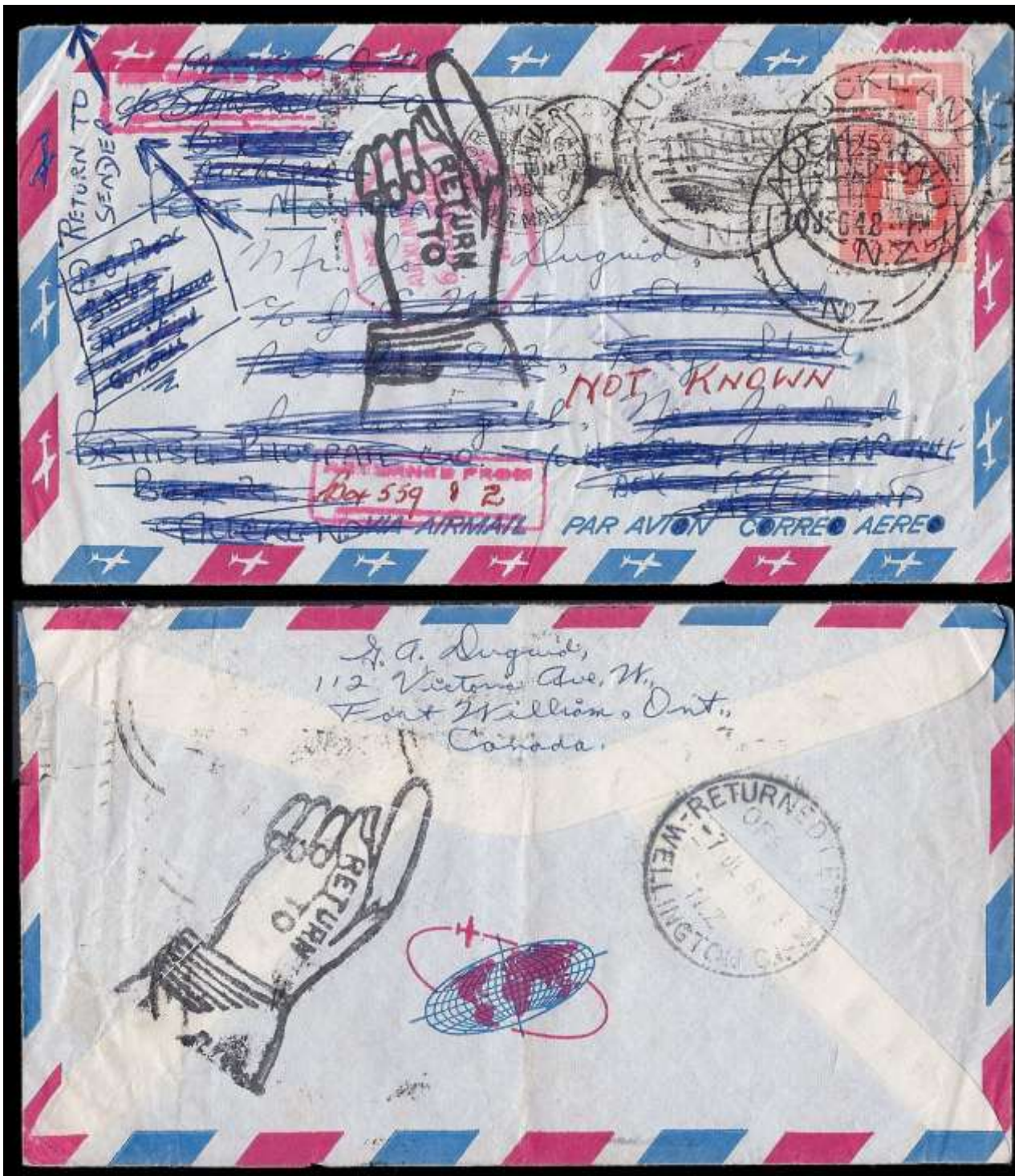
Item 134-12 – 1935, Amherstburg Ont (Essex), 13c Citadel tied by cds paying 13c registered letter rate to US. R boxed with original No. hs and registered oval hs. \$40.00



Item 134-13 – 1942, **D'Arcy Station Saskatchewan**, 1c War, 1c, 2c Mufti tied by grid paying 5c UPU letter rate to Switzerland. Censored by Canadian authorities (DB/248) and German using the Geoffnet Label "Y" which was the Bordeaux Office. **\$45.00 SOLD**



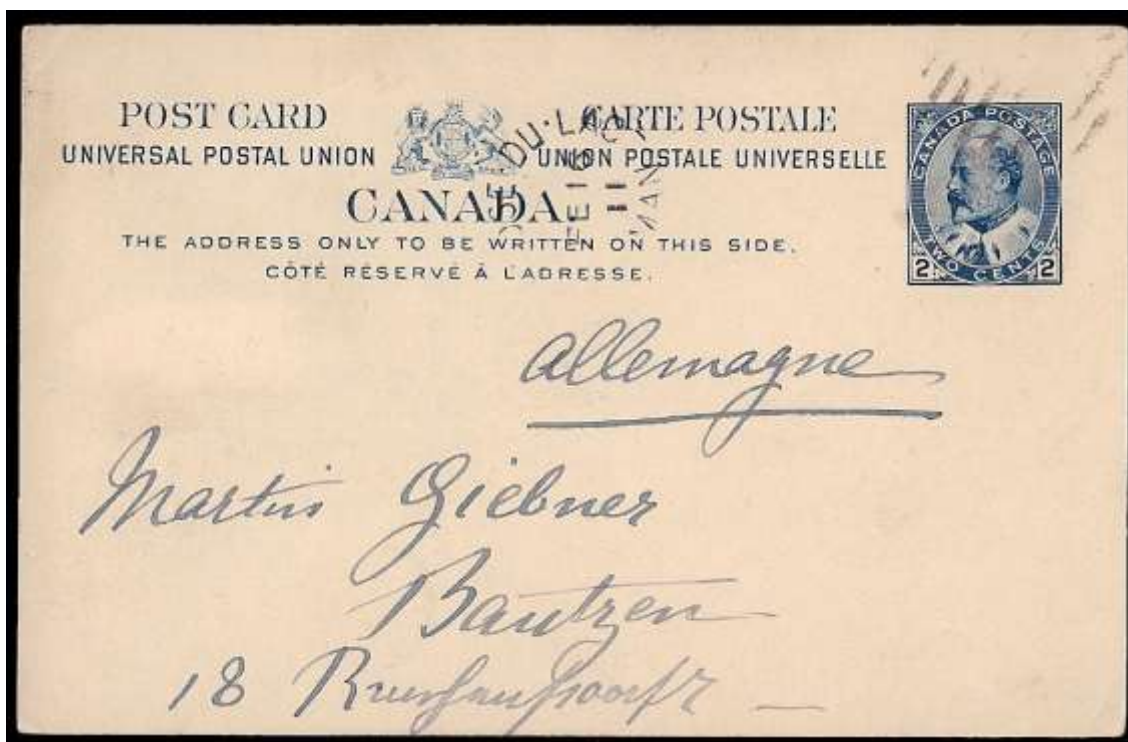
Item 134-14 – 1943, Montreal Que, **cigarette card** to Toronto with message: We have been officially advised by the Post Office Department **of the loss at sea, by Enemy Action**, of your gift package acknowledged to your under serial number Very scarce WW2 item. **\$100.00 SOLD**



Item 134-15 – 1964, Fort William Ont, 25c airmail letter to New Zealand, Much fwd within NZ, eventually returned to Canada. A very busy cover. **\$50.00 SOLD**



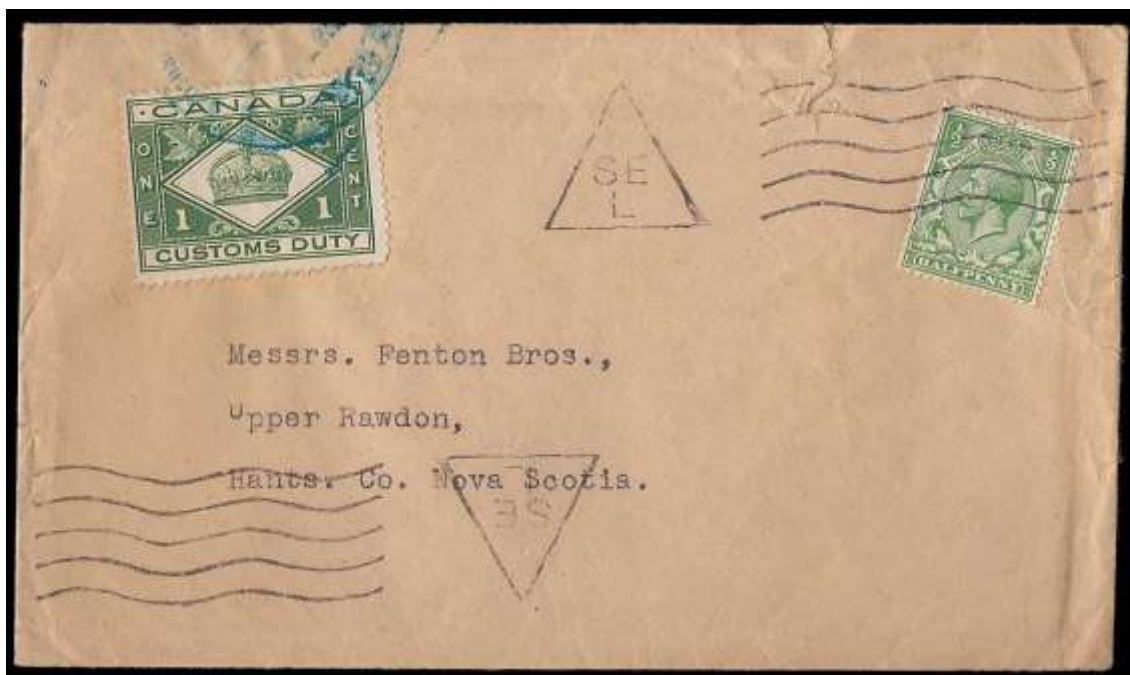
Item 134-16 – 1934, **Quebec Que**, 1c Medallion tied by machine cancel on PC to USA. Shortpaid/2 cents due, (2) 1c US postage due stamps tied by oval Whitman Mass. \$20.00



Item 134-17 – 1911, **Ste. Rose du Lac Manitoba**, P25 paying 2c UPU postcard rate to Germany. Message is from **The Baron Octave de la Rue du Can** ancient army officer. He came in Manitoba in 1903. He farmed and raised horses for the Mounted Police on a 1280 acre property. Message in French is stamp exchange related. If you are interested, google Town of Ste. Rose du Lac Manitoba and see part 5. \$45.00



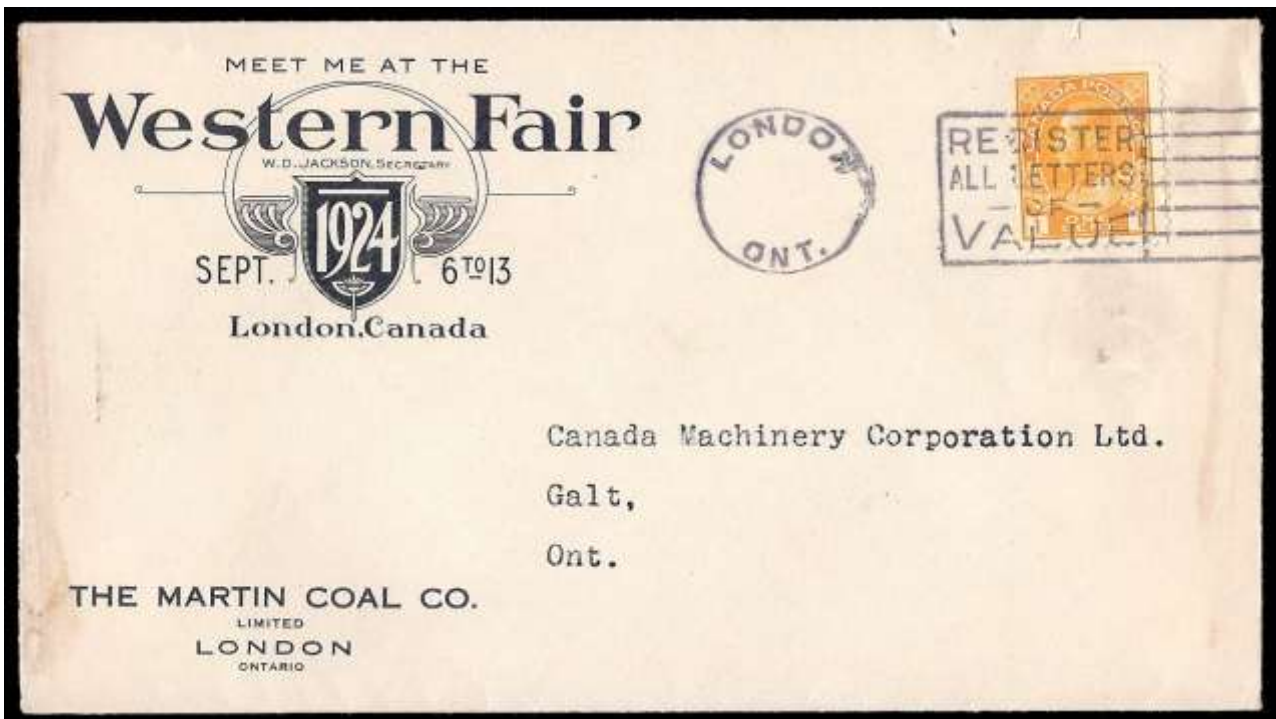
Item 134-18 – 1929, GB ½d printed matter rate to Canada. Franked with VD FCD1 “1c Customs Duty” tied by Halifax National Revenue hs on unsealed cover. No enclosure but we assume that it was inspected in Halifax and advertising was found - therefore charged 1c. \$25.00.



Item 134-19 – 1929, GB ½d printed matter rate to Canada. Franked with VD FCD1 “1c Customs Duty” tied by Halifax National Revenue hs on unsealed cover. No enclosure but we assume that it was inspected in Halifax and advertising was found - therefore charged 1c. \$25.00.



Item 134-20 – 1927, **Winnipeg Man Sub No.15**, 2c Confederation, 5c McGehee, 12c Laurier Macdonald tied by cds paying **19c triple registered letter rate to UK**. Nice rate especially #8 cover and scarce post office which I have not found any information about (location and dates). Back flap off. **\$50.00 SOLD**



Item 134-21 – 1924, **London Ont**, 1c Admiral tied by slogan paying 1c 3rd class to Galt on **Western Fair** advertising cover. **\$30.00 SOLD**



Item 134-22 – 1857, St.Simon CE (St.Simon de Yamaska), 3d to Montreal via St.Hyacinthe (Changeling hammer indicia D in red). This St.Simon double broken circle was known from 1847 to 1855. Here is presumably the new latest recorded date (LRD) for the hammer. **\$75.00 HOLD**



Item 134-23 – 1923, 2c Admiral tied by CAL & VAN RPO BC shortpaying the 6c UPU postcard rate to Switzerland. ms “35” and # J38 10c (2), # J39 15c postage due stamps tied by Egg (Zurich) cds. **\$75.00 SOLD**



Item 134-24 – 1916, **Field Post Office Camp Hughes Manitoba** cds ties 1c Admiral (2) from booklet on postcard to Sask. In 1909, the training camp named "Camp Sewell" was established 10 kilometers west of Carberry Manitoba. The name of the camp was changed in 1915 to "Camp Hughes" in honour of Major-General Sir Sam Hughes, Canada's Minister of Militia and Defence at the time. This FPO is Rarity Factor D. **\$60.00 SOLD**



Item 134-25 – 1936, Coaticook Que, 5c Arch tied by cds paying 5c letter rate to Japan with 6c airmail to Vancouver. **\$60.00 SOLD**



Item 134-26 – 1943, Val D'Or Que, 30c airmail letter rate to Switzerland, censored by Canadian and German (Ab – Berlin Office). **\$35.00 SOLD**



Item 134-27 – 1932, **Toronto Ont**, 10c letter to Germany with airmail service to New York (Jusqu'a) and surface to destination. **\$45.00 SOLD**



Item 134-28 – 1939, **Montreal Place D'Arme Que**, 40c airmail registered letter rate to England. FECB, Passed. **\$30.00 SOLD**



Item 134-29 –1944, Telkwa BC (RF B), airmail letter to Switzerland, censored by Canadian authorities and German using the Geoffnet Label "b" which was the Berlin Office. **\$40.00 SOLD**



Item 134-30 – 1905, **Toronto Station B**, 5c Edward tied by IMC paying 5c UPU letter rate to Germany. \$30.00
